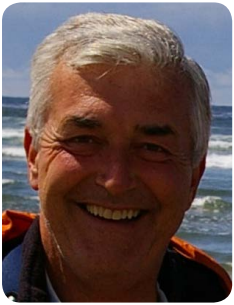


# A Note from the President

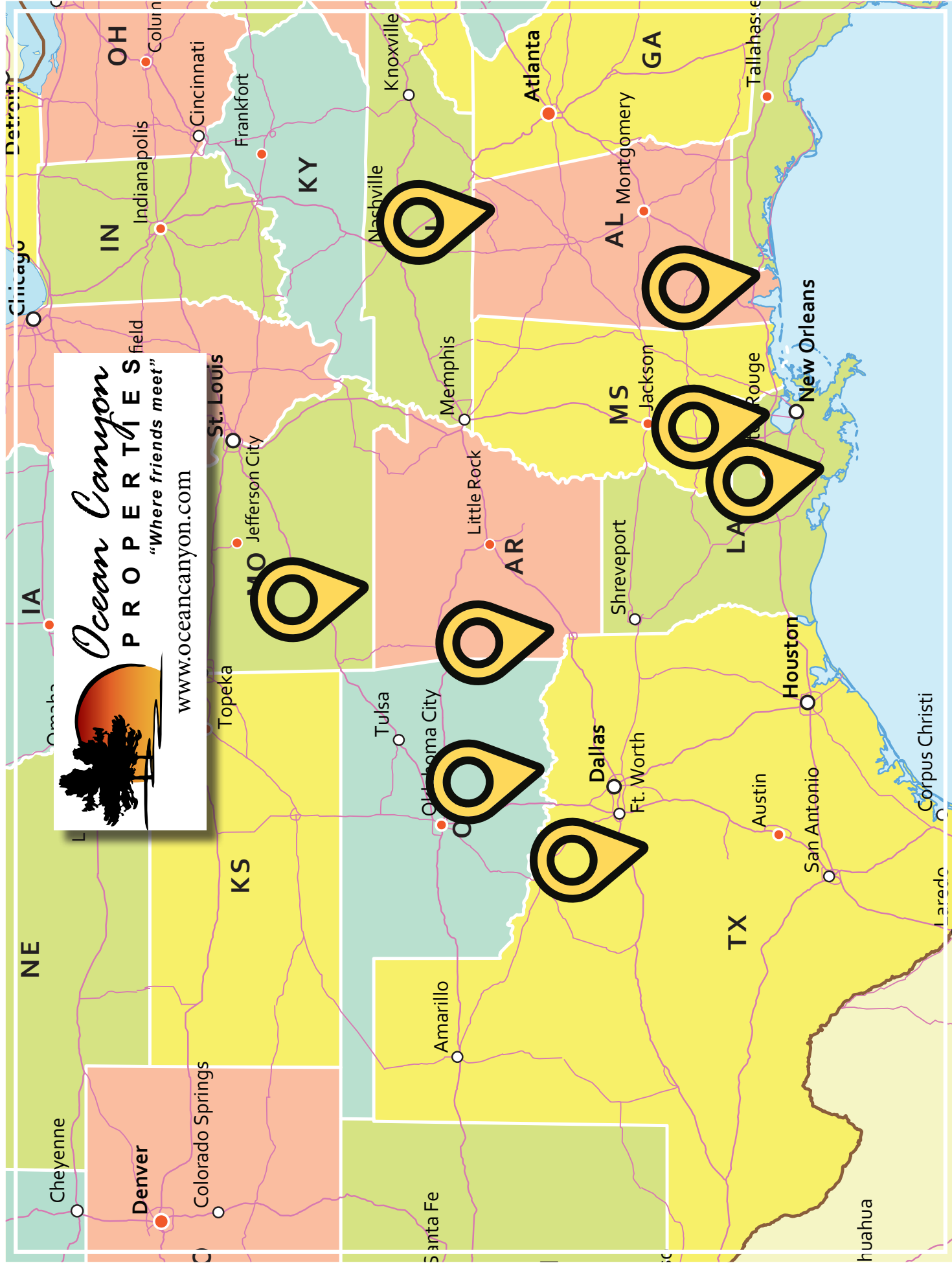

flower beds have been added. Currently, we are working on adding new decks to the cabins. The kids are really enjoying the new playground and members are enjoying the new washing equipment that has been added.

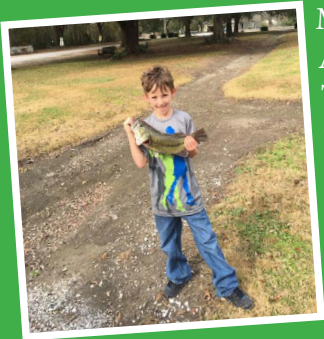
In addition to the renovations that have already taken place, during the 2018 year, the Hideaway Ponds Clubhouse is expected to undergo some major improvements, both inside and out.

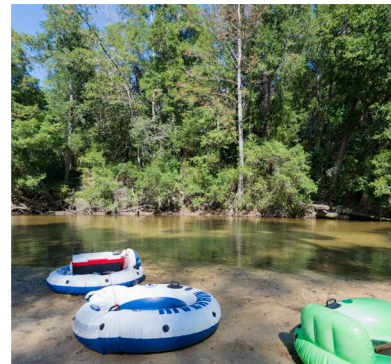


help make 2017 a success, because there are so many. We would like to take this opportunity to thank each of you who helped make our events and
